## Roadway Stream Crossing Assessment Jennie Webber Creek at Cross Country Road

## **Crossing description:**

- Road condition has been impassable since 2021
- There are two culverts at this site, one of 4 ft diameter and one of 5.5 ft diameter
- Both structures show severe deterioration from corrosion or abrasion (more than 50% of the 4 ft structure is rusted through)
- Both structures show ongoing major subsurface erosion/piping (water flowing around the structure) and partial fill failure
- Water velocity was measured at 4.9 ft/sec in May 2022. A velocity in excess of 3 ft/sec causes a barrier to movement of fish and other aquatic organisms

## Other factors to consider:

- Jennie Creek, a tributary of Jennie Webber Creek, is a Class 2 trout stream
- For the stream size they serve, both structures are undersized
- Structures do not meet buried depth standards
