Petition to Establish Tug Lake District

TO: Board of Supervisors for Lincoln County

We, the undersigned land owners (the "Petitioners") hereby petition the Lincoln County Board of Supervisors to establish a public inland lake protection and rehabilitation district pursuant to authority vested in Chapter 33, Wisconsin Statutes, and state that:

1. The district, if established, shall be known as the Tug Lake District ("the District").
2. The proposed District is necessary to define the present and anticipated problems of Tug Lake, to identify their causes and to implement various educational and/or remedial measures to deal with the problems and to undertake activities such as: protection of the fishery, control of harmful blue green algae, aquatic weeds and or invasive species, and reduction and or treatment of harmful sedimentation to abate internal nutrient cycling, and otherwise improve the water health of Tug lake.
3. Establishment of the District will promote the public health, comfort, convenience, necessity and public welfare.
4. The lands to be included within the District will be benefitted by the establishment of the District.
5. The parcels to be included in the proposed District are set forth in Exhibit A attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference. This listing includes parcel numbers in existence as of December 31, 2019 and is intended to identify land to be included in the proposed District. Any land identified in Exhibit A that is assigned a revised parcel number or numbers shall remain in the proposed District.
6. The boundaries of the land described in the preceding paragraph are shown on the attached plat/sketch attached as Exhibit B, indicating the approximate area and boundaries of the proposed District. The District includes all riparian parcels of land on Tug Lake and properties with recorded lake access.

I, Todd Nicklaus, being duly sworn, deposes and says that I am an owner of land within the proposed District and that to the best of my knowledge the allegations of the petition are true and correct; that to the best of my knowledge, all persons who have signed the foregoing Petition are landowners within the boundaries of the proposed District; that the accompanying map and parcel listing indicates the territory to be included in the proposed District; and that the Petition has been signed by persons who comprise more than 51% of all the owners eligible to sign as owners of the land in the proposed District and whose lands comprise more than 51% of the lands within the proposed District.
