- 5-year review and approval of Dane County L&W Resource management 10-year plan – focused on 5 main points – continued increase in number of contracts and \$\$\$ (\$3.0 million+) of local, state, & federal cost share funding programs, mainly related to the whole Yahara watershed – community manure management program – establishing a demonstration farm network utilizing \$1.0 million grant from NRCS – PFAS – summary of the county’s outreach programs and schedules ... super awesome comprehensive report in great detail...27 pages .
- 2023 CREP (Conservation Reserve Enhancement Program) Spending Authority Report – and request for increased allocation – does not apply to Oneida County (OC does not receive any funds from this program)
- Update on LWCB Research Committee - a survey is being distributed to get feed back on research and educational needs related to agricultural soil & water conservation in Wisconsin – survey will be available on the DATCP website.
- Several agency reports/updates – FSA, NRCS, UW- CALS & Extension, WIL&WA, DATCP, DNR
