

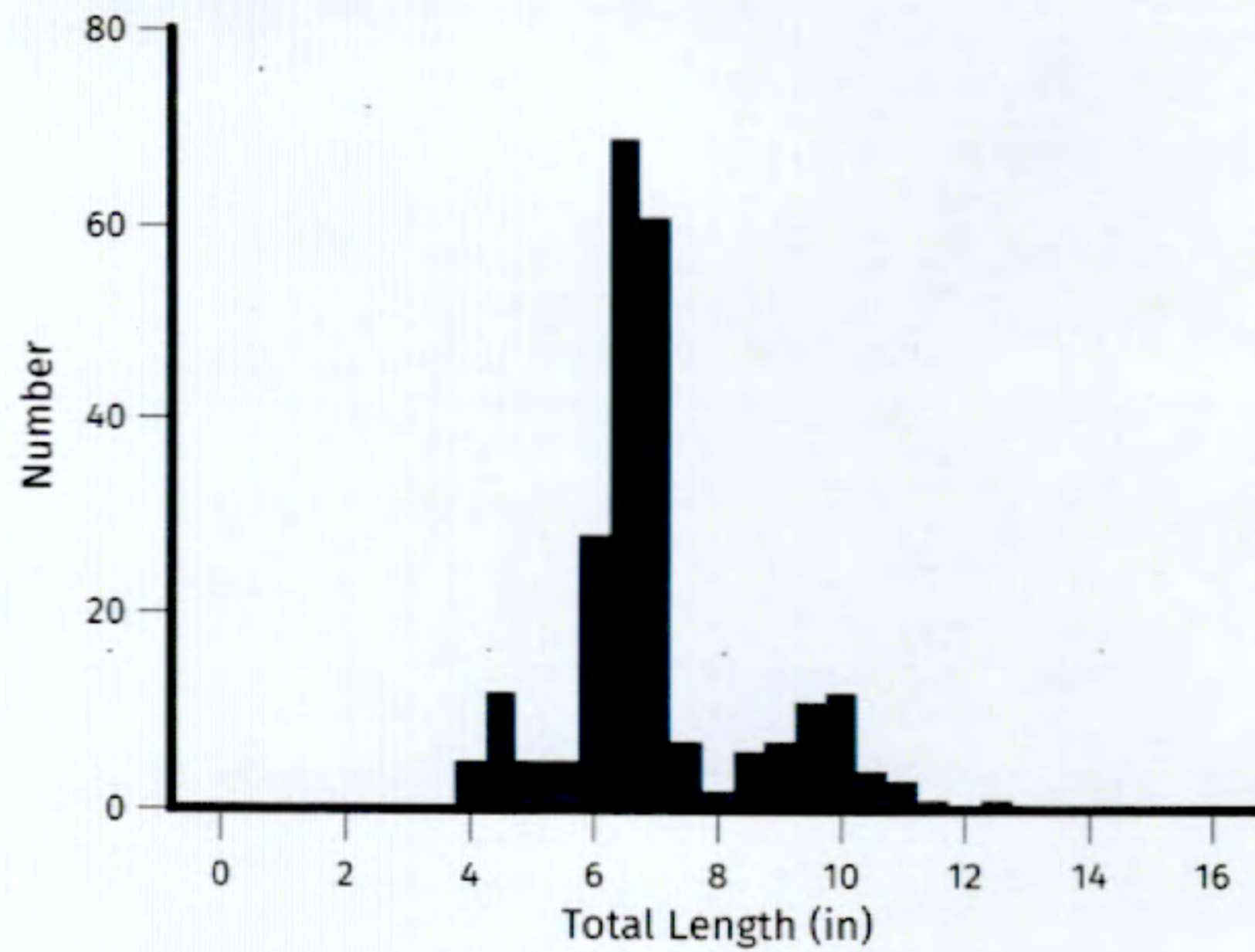

a small size structure was found with 6% of measured black crappies being 10 inches or greater but has improved since the 2006 survey

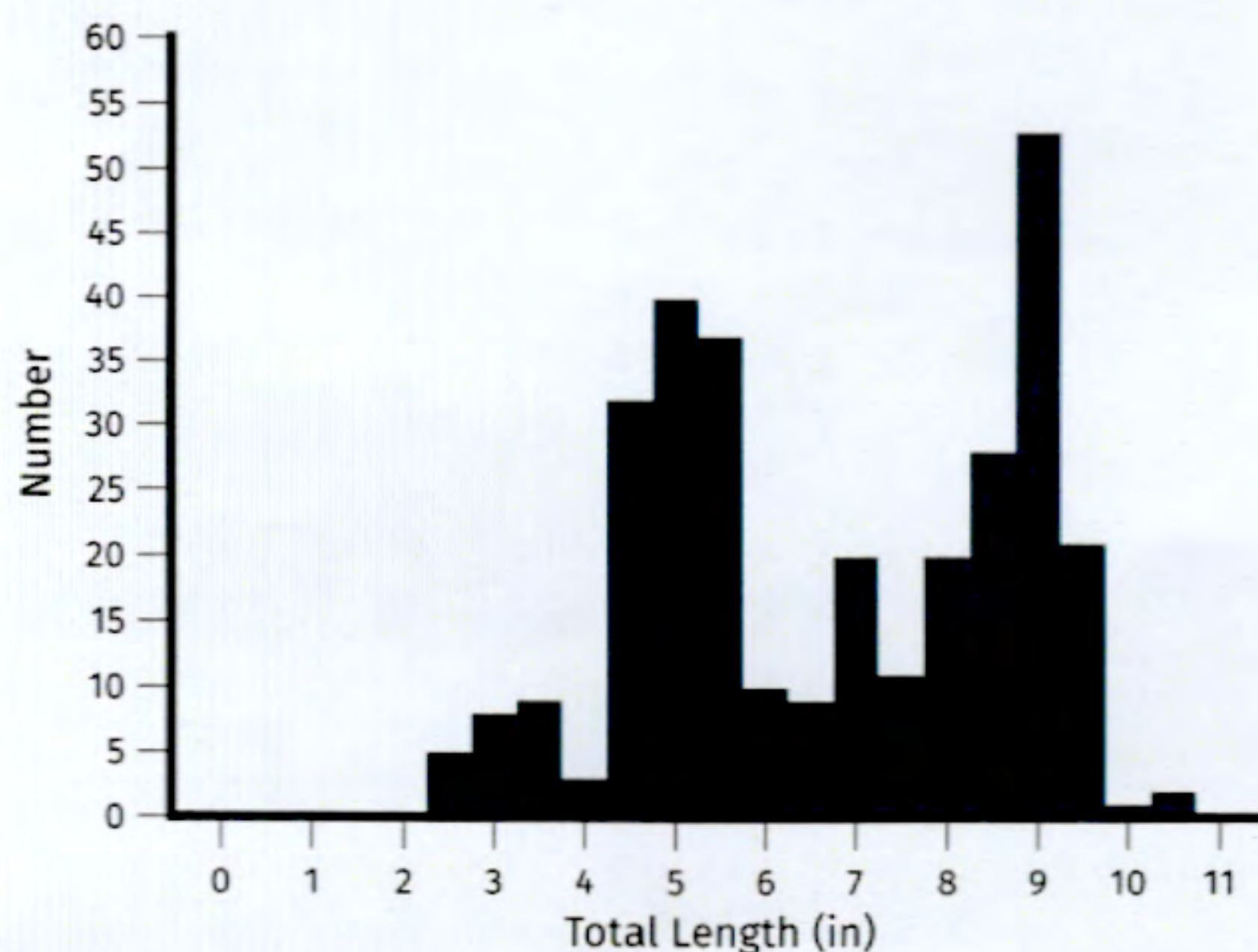

lengths of measured bluegills varied between 2.6 inches to 10.5 inches
mean length of 6.7 inches
a great size structure was found with 57% of measured individuals being 6 inches or greater

0.5 per net night during netting

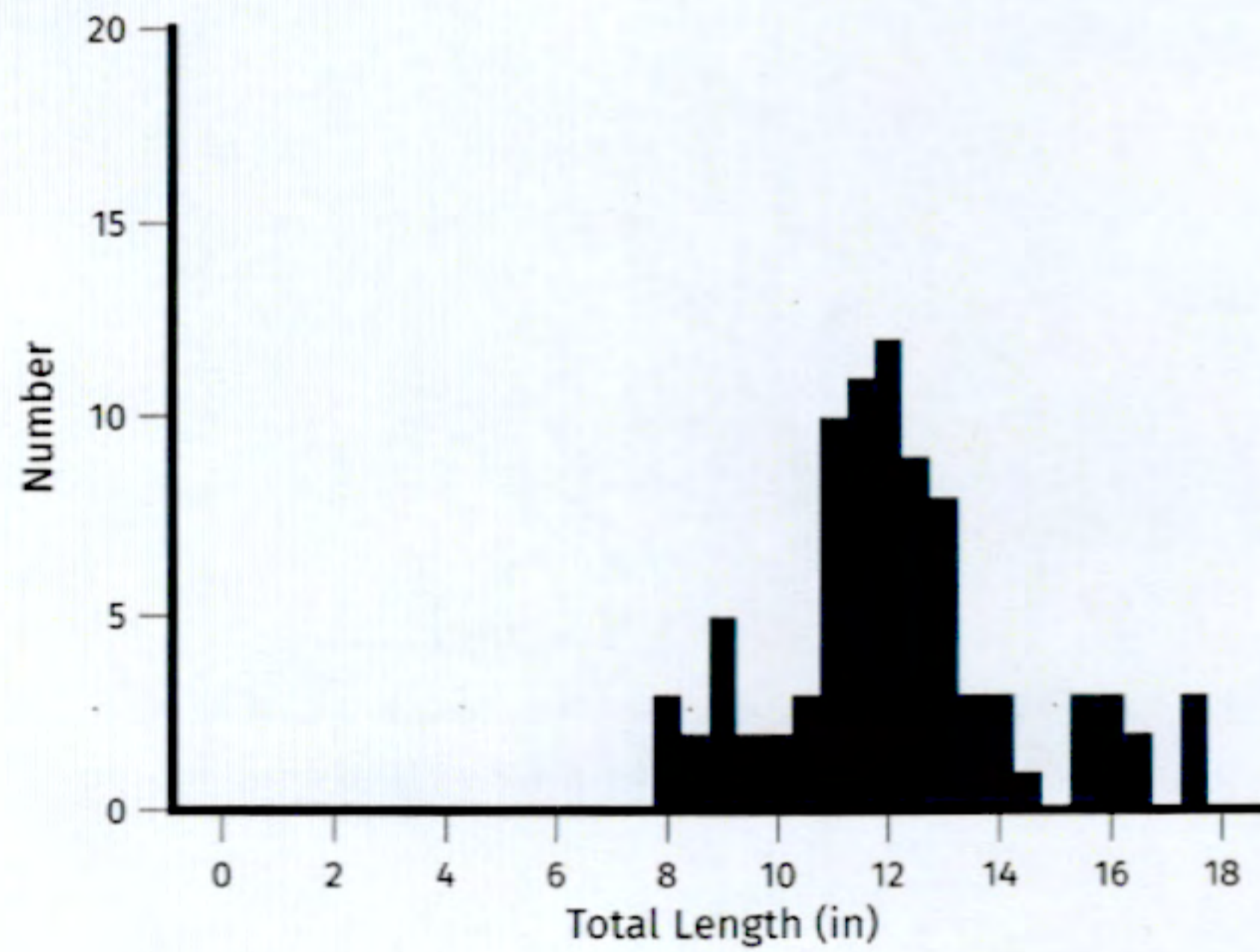
6.3 per mile during electrofishing

lengths varied between 8.2 inches to 18.4 inches

mean length of 12.4 inches

a decent size structure of largemouth bass was found with 52.8% of measured individuals being 12 inches or greater



MUSKELLUNGE

2 muskellunge were captured

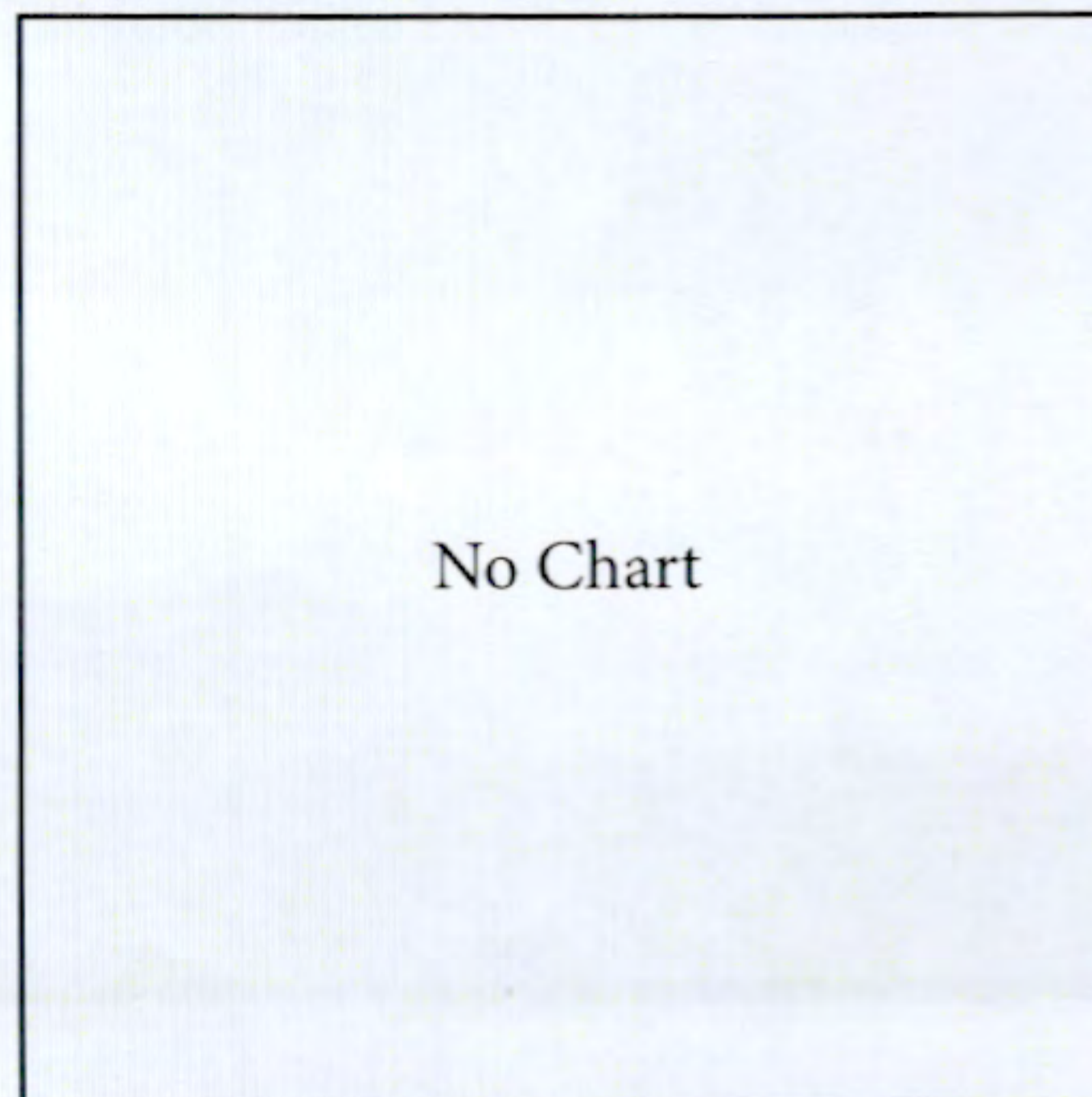

lengths of muskellunge varied between 25.5 inches to 42.5 inches

NORTHERN PIKE

2,211 northern pike were captured
catch rate was 45.0 per net night during netting

8.5 per mile during electrofishing

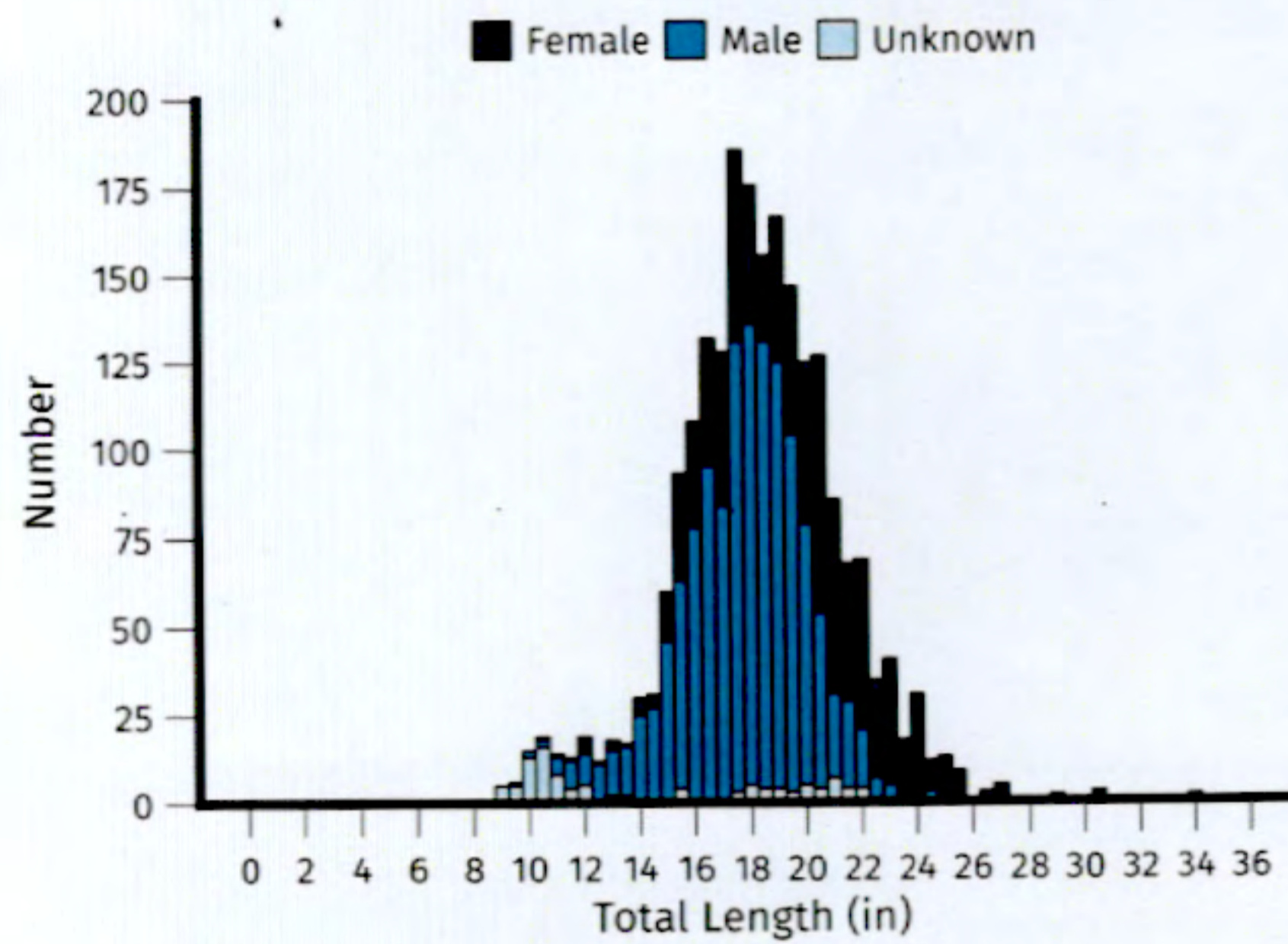
northern pike population was estimated to be $10,020 \pm 732$ fish (5.7/acre), an increase from the 2006 estimate of $7,910 \pm 2,04$ (4.5/acre).

lengths of northern pike varied between 7.5 inches to 36.0 inches

mean length of 18.4 inches

a small size structure of northern pike was found with 19.6 % of measured individuals being 21 inches or greater

northern pike size structure has decreased with a lower proportion of individuals in the quality and preferred sizes in 2023 compared to 2006



PUMPKINSEED

1,535 pumpkinseed were captured

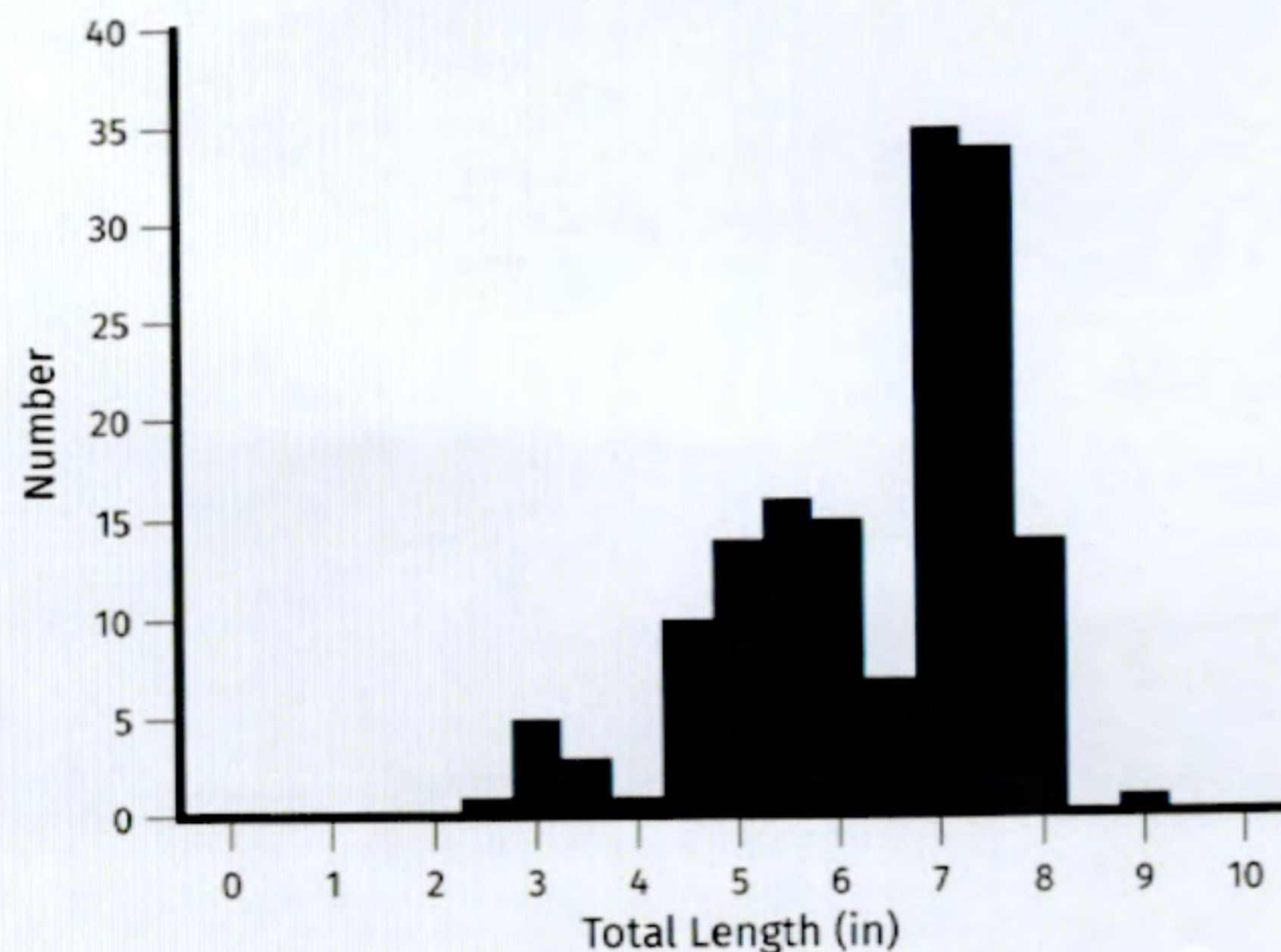
31.6 per net night during netting

25.0 per mile during electrofishing.

varied between 2.8 inches to 8.8 inches

mean length of 6.3 inches

a great size structure was found with only 65% of Pumpkinseeds being 6 inches or greater

Walleye catch per mile was in the 68th percentile statewide

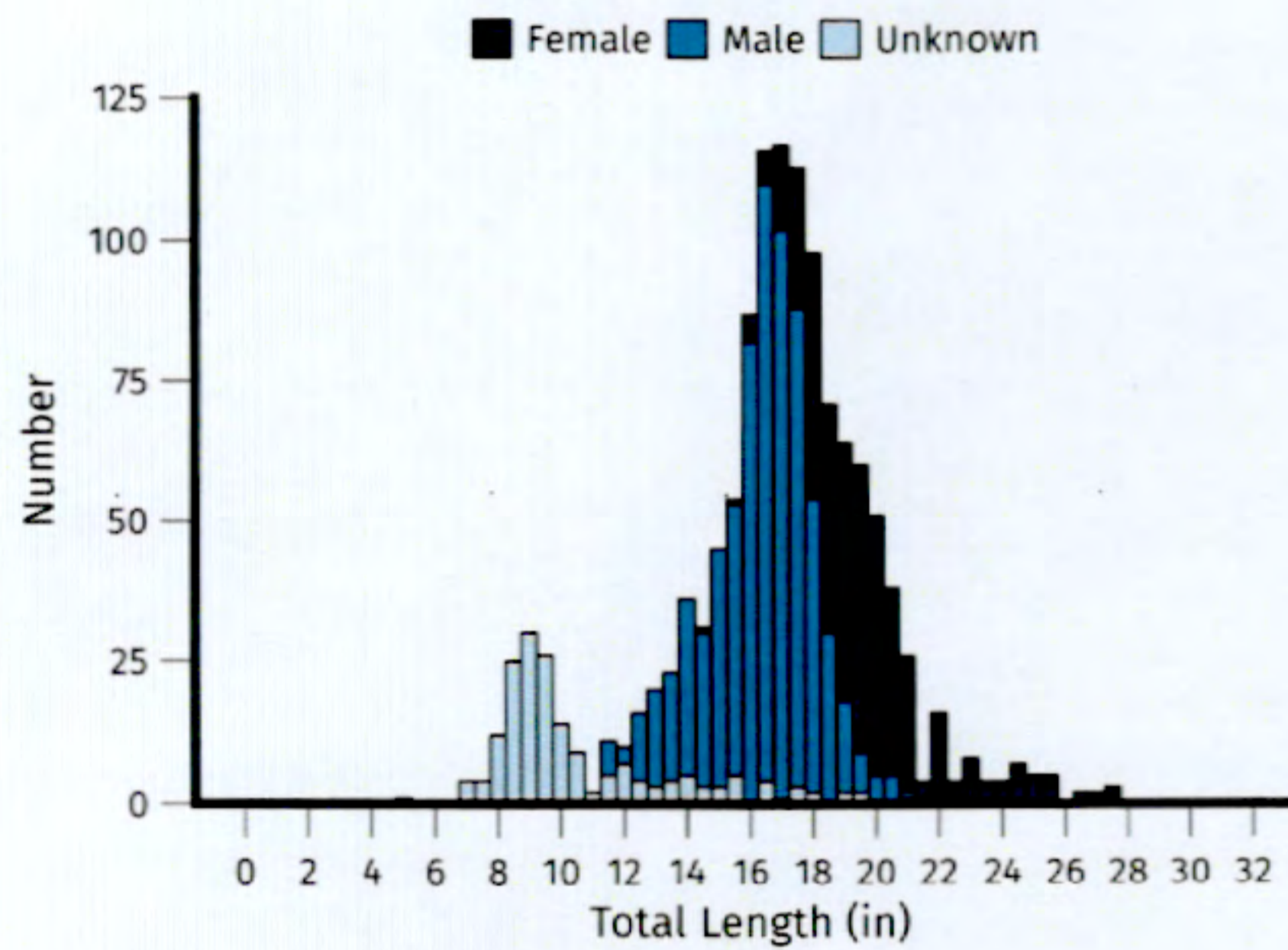
lengths varied between 5.0 inches to 27.5 inches

mean length of 16.6 inches

a great size structure was of Walleyes was found with 85.2% of measured individuals being 15 inches or greater

female Walleye tended to be larger than males

size structure has decreased slightly with fewer individuals in the quality and preferred sizes in 2023 compared to ~~2023~~ 2006



YELLOW PERCH

1,847 yellow perch were captured

37.2 per net night during netting

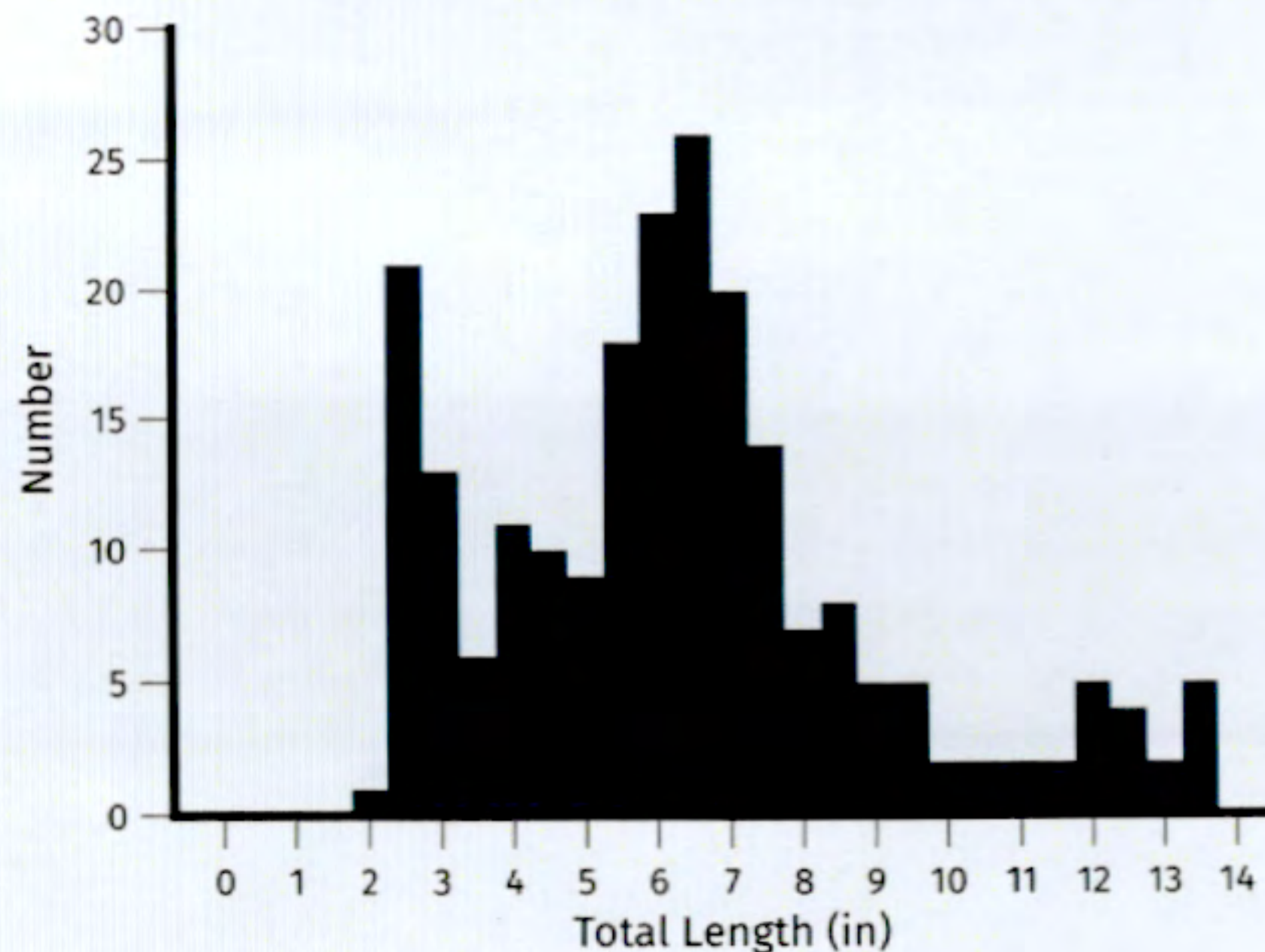
50.0 per mile during electrofishing
