| 28.03(1) | Failure to obtain a permit for a new or substantially altered manure storage facility | \$200.00 |
| 28.03(2) | Failure to install safety devices for a manure storage facility | \$150.00 |
| 28.04(1)(a) | Allowing manure to overflow from a manure storage facility | \$250.00 |
| 28.04(1)(b) | Allowing an unconfined manure stack in a water quality management area | \$200.00 |
| 28.04(1)(c) | Allowing runoff from a feedlot or stored manure into the waters of the state | \$250.00 |
| 28.04(1)(d) | Allowing livestock unlimited access to waters of the state in a location where high concentrations of animals prevent the maintenance of adequate sod or self-sustaining vegetative cover | \$250.00 |
| 28.04(2) | Allowing a manure storage facility or manure stacks of any size within prohibited setback to well, road, or property line | \$200.00 |
| 28.04(3) | Allowing a manure storage facility or manure stacks of any size within prohibited setback to a navigable water or wetland | \$200.00 |
| 28.05 | Failure to obtain a permit for a new manure storage facility or substantially altered existing manure storage facility | \$200.00 |
| 28.06 | Operating a manure storage facility without a certificate of use | \$200.00 |
