COST SHARE PROJECT Engineered Practices - (for project requiring the expertise of LWC Engineer, such as: Rock RipRap; Envirolock Bag Walls, Curlex Blocs, etc.)	\$1,000.00	Deposit refunded upon project completion and with DATCP and LWCD approval.
COST SHARE PROJECT Non-Engineered Practices - (Examples include: Plantings; Rain Gardens, etc.)	\$500.00	Deposit refunded upon project completion and with DATCP and LWCD approval.

** If a project consists of Engineered **AND** Non-Engineered practices, the deposit shall be \$1,000.00.

Additional Notes:

1. A county cost share application must already be on file.
2. Deposit must be submitted and this agreement signed, prior to the start of plan design.
3. If the Landowner terminates the project after the plan has been developed, Landowner will forfeit the deposit to Oneida County Land and Water Conservation Department.
