

## Summary of Supervisor Holewinski's comments from the CUW meeting 1-10-22

- Does ordinance affect all small farms in Oneida County? Jennrich: Yes. Regulates manure.
- How many farms were investigated in 22 years? Jennrich: One, no violation to his recollection.
- How many farmers involved in writing this ordinance? Engel: One. Sadauskas: We used our Farm Service Agency Committee member as a farm representative (John Engel).
- Did DNR attend any Committee meetings? Mott: No. Sadauskas: DATCP and DNR reviewed the MSO.
- Why was 92.11 left out of 28.01 (1)? Page 28-1
- Why does the ordinance only apply to unincorporated areas of Oneida County? 28.01(5) Page 28-2.

### Complaints:

- 3 minute time limit for farmer input
- Expected everyone at public hearing to understand ordinance
- No presentation on ordinance. No highlighting of anything.
- Didn't mention Chapter 25 fee schedule, which would affect farmers.
- County Code was not followed. 2.03
- No economic impact or environmental impact statement done. 92.11(3)
