EROSION AND SEDIMENT CONTROL PRODUCTS WEBINAR SERIES

July 30, August 6, and August 11 (8:30-10:00 a.m.)

Thursday, July 30 - General Overview of Erosion and Sediment Control: This presentation will go over, generally, most of what you will see out there for erosion blankets and sediment devices. Riley Stenzel from the American Excelsior Company will talk about their research lab and what they have found works the best. Blankets have many different biodegradable fills and netting options that he will touch on. There are also permanent mats that he will review along with when and where to use them compared to a biodegradable option. PDHs and 1.5 Soil and Water Management CEUs will be offered.

Thursday, August 6 - Temporary Biodegradable Blankets: During this presentation Riley Stenzel from the American Excelsior Company will go into more detail on the biodegradable blankets. He will talk about installation details and the pros and cons of all the different options of these blankets. He will talk about all the netting and fill options, their life spans, and what they are approved for in the field. PDHs and 1.5 Soil and Water Management CEUs will be offered.

Tuesday, August 11 - Turf Reinforcement Mats: Riley Stenzel from the American Excelsior Company will talk about the different permanent erosion blankets out there and what they can hold up to. The second part of the presentation will cover uses of coir logs, including filtering water, damming water, and bank protection. PDHs and 1.5 Soil and Water Management CEUs will be offered.
