

# Yellow Iris Harvesting- Indian Mounds Boat Launch, Lake Tomahawk

Aubrey and I went out to the public boat landing at Indian Mounds in Lake Tomahawk to dig up some yellow iris plants. There were many plants growing in large clumps along the shoreline. Some were right on the water and their roots were exposed due to the shoreline erosion. We did not have native plants on hand to replace it with, so we left those plants to keep the shoreline intact. Some had extensive root systems already. We pulled about 20 plants from this site and disposed of them in the dumpsters of Clear Lake Campground.
